21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isn't it a bit weird that Catholics call the Pope "papa," father? This Sunday provides us with essential Scriptural background on the papacy, the petrine office. Jesus gives Peter the "keys to the kingdom of heaven," after witnessing to the special grace Peter has to know Jesus' true identity. Many have pointed out that the "keys" refer back to the figure of Eliakim, King David's prime minister. True enough. But notice this is not mere authority or power. It's a family relationship. The Lord says to Eliakim, "He shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem" (Isaiah 22:21). David's prime minister was a spiritual father to the family of Israel. Peter, and his successors, will be spiritual fathers in the family of the Church.

This means we have a serious obligation to not only recognize the Pope's authority, but also to love him with the affection of children for their papa. We should never speak about him with disrespect or rancor. We should listen to him with trusting hearts, and ignore the slander thrown at him in various media. When we show the world we are loving and obedient to our Holy Papa, perhaps they'll see more clearly that the Church is indeed God's beloved family.

HONORING OUR PAST

A MOMENT IN ST. FRANCIS XAVIER PARISH HISTORY Years 1961-1964

In these 3 years SFX Parish was ministered by two priests: Father Carly Green and Msgr. Gerald Poelker..

- Father Caryle Green was the pastor from 1961-1963. He was born in St Louis, MO in 1909. He was ordained into the priesthood in St. Joseph, MO on May 26, 1935.
- Father Green was assigned to SFX Parish in 1961. He succeeded Rev. Bernard Mers, who had been the pastor since 1949. There isn't much information recorded about him in our history books.
- His stay at St. Francis was short-lived. He was sent to Assumption Parish in Morrison, MO in 1963. He died only 3 months later on June 21, 1963 at the age of 54.
- Msgr. Gerald Poelker also had a brief stay as pastor, 1963-1964. He was born in St. Louis on Sept. 1, 1917. He graduated from Kenrick Seminary and was ordained in 1942 by the late Cardinal Glennon.
- Msgr. Poelker worked in the Chancery and served as Diocesan Superintendent of Schools while serving as pastor of several parishes.
- While his stay at SFX was short, he was instrumental in helping design a four room addition to the school as well as a new gathering area which became known as Helias Hall.
- Msgr. Poelker also oversaw the exhumation of the body of Father Helias on Feb. 29, 1964 under the direction of Dulle Funeral Home. The new burial site was designed for the vestibule of the church. Father Helias was re-entombed on Memorial Day, 1964.
- During 1963-64, SFX parish was grateful to also have an assistant pastor. His name was Father Henry Reichert.
