Empty Glass Jars



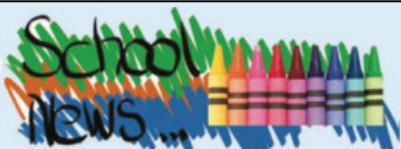
